

Early Bronze Age

We can see in all areas of the Aegean the same phenomenon, although of different intensity:

- EB I-IIA – fast development of art, crafts, social organization
- EB IIB – a crisis (the strongest in the Cyclades, then in the Mainland)
- EB III – the emergence of new forms, transition to MB

Early Bronze Age in the Mainland Greece

(Early Helladic)

Chronology:

- EH I – Eutresis culture
- EH IIA – Korakou culture
- EH IIB – Lefkandi I culture (Boeotia, E. coast and islands), Korakou culture
- EH III – Tiryns culture
