* Facultative courses may be selected from the offer for the particular academic year. Total number of ECTS should be 6. In the MA studies programme lectures and classes described here as facultative courses are counted for 3 ECTS per 30 hours. The same lectures and classes in the BA studies programme may be counted for 2 ECTS per 30 hours and described as optional classes. The number of working hours differs in both cases.

** Monographic lectures may be selected from the offer for the particular academic year. Those students, who study only on the MA studies programme may choose any obligatory lecture from the offer of the BA studies as their monographic lecture.

*** Lectures on Humanities offered to all the students studying in English at the University of Warsaw (OGUN) or lectures offered to all students studying in English in the Institute of Archaeology (IA UW lecture) indicated in the schedule for the particular year. It is possible to take one lecture in two semesters (60 hrs) or two lectures in two semesters (2 x 30 hrs). General humanities lectures (OGUN) are counted for 1.5 ECTS for 30 hours, 3 ECTS for 60 hours. **Students who started their studies in 2017/18 will receive 5 ECTS for OGUN lectures (60 hours) and 14 ECTS for excavations.**

**** Total sum of ECTS should not exceed 10% (66 points). Total sum of ECTS should not exceed 10% (99 points). Attention: some lectures and classes are counted for 3 and some other for 6 ECTS.
