In April 2021 ($22^{nd} - 25^{th}$) the 5^{th} students symposium on archaeology (SABA) will take place in the World-Heritage city of Bamberg, Germany.

The conference will encompass all of the branches of archaeology taught at the University of Bamberg. These are as follows:

- Prehistoric Archaeology
- Medieval Archaeology
- Archaeology of the Roman Provinces
- Geoarchaeology

However, submissions from other branches of archaeology as well as presentations on the topic of "pandemics and diseases in archaeology" are very much welcome.

Due to the everchanging news and uncertainties regarding the Covid-19 pandemic, the symposium will take place in form of an online live-stream, until further notice. In case of drastic improvements and the possibilities of safe entry, however, the symposium will be relocated to its original setting at the University of Bamberg (Germany).

Prospective archaeologists will have the opportunity to present their theses (BA/MA) to a wider audience and participate in a constructive discourse. Students of the archaeological sciences from all over Europe are invited to the conference. We will provide partial covering for travel expenses to all speakers.
