Students decide the specialisation they want to choose for their Master Thesis (either *I. Bioarchaeology* or *II. Near East Archaeology*). According to this choice they have to choose the appropriate obligatory courses (Obligatory courses I if *Bioarchaeology* is chosen or Obligatory courses II if *Near East Archaeology* is chosen) and, similarly, the appropriate obligatory workshop (either *Bioarchaeology* or *Exploring Academic Research Papers*). The course that a student is not obliged to pass as a part of their specialisation can be chosen as a facultative course (e.g. a Bioarchaeology student can choose *Aspects of Ancient Egyptian Culture* as a facultative course).
