

Zbigniew T. Fiema received an M.A. from Warsaw University (1980) and a Ph.D. from University of Utah (1991). He has held numerous academic and research appointments, including Visiting Professor and Research Fellow at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin and research and teaching posts at University of Helsinki, as well as fellowships from the Academy of Finland. From 1992 to 1997 he served as Chief Archaeologist at the American Center of Oriental Research and later directed major international projects in Jordan and Saudi Arabia, collaborating with institutions such as the Centre National des Recherches Scientifiques. His fieldwork spans the Mediterranean and Middle East, with leadership roles in surveys and excavations in Jordan and Arabia, and beyond.
